1. Introduction

This document provides an overview of enhancements in the new DMAP DB Migration Image version 2026.02.0.1 & Binary version 8.5.3.7 and DMAP App Migration Image version 2026.02.0.1 & Binary version 8.5.3.7 Images are docker image that is used to launch docker based containers for DMAP DB & App. Binary refers to a release with hot fixes and enhancements to DMAP functionality that is deployed in Azure BLOB storage. Binary file is automatically downloaded and refreshed whenever container is stopped and started again.

3. Installation Procedure

Please refer to Installation guide to install & upgrade DMAP. Please follow below instructions if they are applicable to you.

DMAP DB Migration:

- Take backup of your current DMAP container data prior to using the new image. You can later use this backup to restore the DMAP data for Assessment and Conversion done using DMAP in the new container you will launch with new DMAP image.
- DMAP image v2026.02.0.1 has been updated in DMAP offer in Azure Marketplace. [DMAP Oracle to Azure PostgreSQL Migration \(microsoft.com\)](https://marketplace.azure.com/offer/00000000-0000-0000-0000-000000000000)
- If you retrieve DMAP image from Docker Hub, then use below command to pull the image.
`docker pull ngdmapo/dmap_db_prod:v2026.02.0.1`

DMAP App Migration:

- Take backup of your current DMAP container data prior to using the new image. You can later use this backup to restore the DMAP data for Assessment and Conversion done using DMAP in the new container you will launch with new DMAP image.
- DMAP image v2025.09.0.1 has been updated in DMAP offer in Azure Marketplace. [DMAP App Migration \(microsoft.com\)](#)
- If you retrieve DMAP image from Docker Hub, then use below command to pull the image.
`docker pull ngdmapo/dmap_app_prod:v2026.02.0.1`

4. Minimum Image Requirements

Data migration binary release version **8.5.3.7** requires DMAP data migration Image version **2026.02.0.1**. And Application migration binary release version **8.5.3.7** requires Image version of **2026.02.0.1** If you are running DMAP DB container with an older version of image, then it is mandatory to upgrade to version **2026.02.0.1 or latest** and DMAP App Container to version **2026.02.0.1 or latest**. DMAP binary is automatically downloaded from Azure BLOB storage and refreshed in the container whenever the container is stopped and started again. If you do not upgrade the DMAP image, then DMAP may not run correctly.
